

# AUTUMN TERM, WE ARE LEARNING ABOUT....

## Nursery

How have I changed since I was a baby?

In Nursery, the children will learn how they have changed since they were babies and about close members of their families. They will create a timeline from being a baby to a child.

## Reception

What is a family?

In Reception, the children will learn about extended member of their family. They will learn more about their school, local community and how they travel to school.

## Year One

Where is my home?

In Year 1, the children will learn about the local community and where they live. They will also learn about what communication is and how aspects of communication have changed over the years.

## Year 6

How has America tackled injustice?

In Year 6, the children will learn about the slave trade and significant individuals who brought about positive change to fight for justice and the rights of individuals.

## Year 5

How have the railways changed our lives?

In Year 5, children will learn about the Industrial Revolution and how the railways had a positive impact during this time in history - particularly in Doncaster.

## Year 4
