- Executive Principal: Mrs Clark



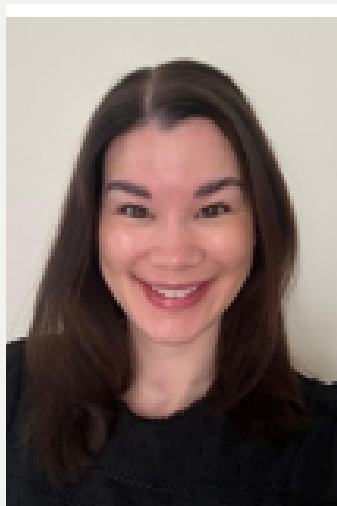

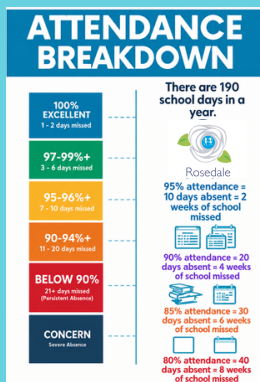

Working together for a fantastic year ahead
As we start a new academic year, please help us by ensuring your child comes to school in the correct uniform every day.

1. OUR UNIFORM

- Navy blue sweatshirt or cardigan with the Rosedale logo (optional)
- White polo shirt with the Rosedale logo (optional)
- Grey or black skirt, pinafore dress, shorts or trousers
- Black school shoes (plain) or black trainers (no bright colours)
- White or grey socks or tights

2. PE KIT

- Plain white t-shirt
- Navy or black shorts or navy or black tracksuit bottoms
- Navy or black sweatshirt or hoodie
- Trainers (for outdoor PE)

3. JEWELLERY AND MAKE UP

- Pupils are not permitted to wear jewellery to school (except for small stud earrings and a watch).
- No make-up should be worn. Nail varnish is not permitted.

4. HAIRSTYLES

- Hairstyles should be neat and tidy and not be a distraction to learning.
- Hair accessories should be in school colours (no specific colours stated).
- No hair dye, lines or patterns.

Outdoor black tracksuit and trainers for outdoors

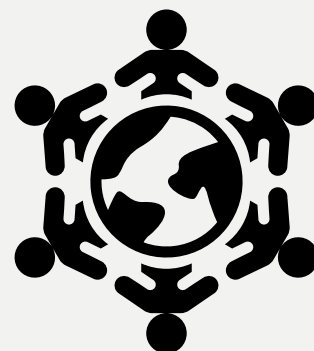
We do have a uniform store in school so if you are needing any support with uniform please contact Miss Bewick.
