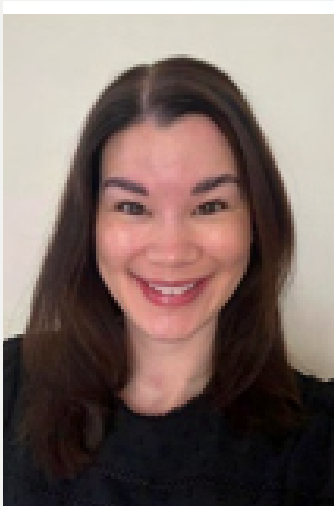


Executive Principal Update

Water Safety Reminder

As the warmer weather continues, we would like to remind all families about the importance of staying safe around open water.

Sadly, over the half-term break, there were a number of tragic incidents across the UK involving young people entering rivers, lakes, reservoirs, and other open water areas.

Whilst open water can appear inviting on hot days, it can be extremely dangerous. Cold water shock, hidden currents, steep banks, and underwater hazards can put even strong swimmers at risk.

We encourage parents and carers to speak with their children about the dangers of swimming in open water and the importance of only swimming in supervised, designated areas. If children find themselves in difficulty in the water, they should remember the advice to Float to Live: tilt your head back, keep your ears submerged, relax, and use your hands to help you stay afloat until you can control your breathing and call for help.

We will continue to promote water safety with the pupils in our planned assemblies and workshops for both KS1 and KS2 in the coming weeks.
