

SPRING TERM, WE ARE LEARNING ABOUT....

Nursery

Why do we make the right choice?

In Nursery, the children will learn what is right or wrong through stories. They will learn how to share and why we make the right choices.

Reception

What is the impact of littering?

In Reception, the children will learn people who help us and their roles in society. They will understand the need for rules in different contexts and familiar situations in the past.

Year 6

What aspects of power and leadership led the allies to victory in WW2?

In Year 6, the children will learn about World War 2, when this took place and why. They will learn about the leadership of Adolf Hitler and what led the allies to victory during the war.

Year 5

What aspects of power led the Vikings to invade?

In Year 5 children will learn about who the Vikings were, where they came from and why they invaded Britain. They will also learn about how they ruled and what they brought to Britain.

Year 4

What did the Egyptians leave behind?

In Year 4 children will learn who the Egyptians were, the chronology of significant events and why trade was so important in Ancient Egypt.

Year 3

What is the impact of the Roman invasion in Britain?

In Year 3 children will learn about who the Romans were and where they came from. They will learn about the things the Romans left behind which we still use in modern Britain.

Year One

Why do we have a King or Queen?

In Year 1 the children will learn about how England has been ruled by a King or Queen for many years. They will learn about the current Monarch - King Charles and the process for coronating a new Monarch.

Year Two

Who were the Normans?

In Year 2, children will learn about who the Normans were and key individuals of this time. They will find out more about Conisbrough Castle and learn how this is a typical Norman Castle.
