Nursery

Can we grow healthy foods?

In Nursery, the children will learn how we can grow our own food at home. They will learn which fruits and vegetables can be home grown. They will learn about the importance of healthy eating.

Reception

What is the impact of littering?

In Reception, the children will learn the importance of caring for our community. They will learn about the impact littering is having on our oceans.

Year One

Would you like to live at the seaside?

In Year 1 the children will compare and contrast the human and physical features between Scawsby and a seaside town. They will also learn about the different Continents and Oceans of the world.

Year 6

How can we make a difference?

In Upper Key Stage 2, the children will learn about the causes and impact of Climate Change. They will learn about the difference between renewable and non-renewable energy. They will also find out more about the work of Greta Thunburg.

Year 5

Why are our natural resources being exploited?

In Year 5 children will learn about what a rainforest is and where they are located across the world. They will study the different layers of the rainforest and the devastating impact deforestation is having.

Year 4

What is the impact of natural disasters?

In Year 4, the children will learn about the different natural disasters and where in world they are likely to occur. They will use a world map to locate the different tectonic plates

Year 3

Rivers: Friends or Foe?

In Year 3 children will learn about the water cycle and the features of a river. They will look at the impact of previous flooding with a case study of the floods in Doncaster.

Year Two

How far does our food travel?

In Year 2, the children will learn about where our food comes. They will learn about fairtrade and the importance of this. They use world maps to find out more about the world and where the hot/cold countries are located
