

HISTORY

What did the Victorians wear on the beach?

The children will focus on changes within living memory. Our focus this term will be Victorian beaches.

We will begin with looking at what beaches look like now. Moving on to how they looked in Victorian times.

We will then be comparing Victorian holidays from the past and how they are the same or different now.

By the end of the topic the children will have made comparison on how Victorian's travelled to go on holiday and how holiday's are similar or different then and now.

GEOGRAPHY

Why is summer hot?

We will look at the four seasons and how the weather changes throughout the year. We will then look at what clothing we should wear in different seasons. Finally we will name and locate the four seas surrounding the UK. This will be continued Year 5 when they learn about rivers.

ART

We will be developing our drawing skills by learning how to sketch and the different sketch types. We will then put these skills into place by learning how to complete observational drawing.

SCIENCE

What do plants need to grow?

During this term the children will focus on plants and the weather. We will explore the parts of a plant and what their jobs are. We will also look at growing plants and what plants need to grow.

Through the term we will also look at common plants and trees around us.

Finally we will look at the season and what are longer and shorter days. We will look at the weather and how it changes throughout the year.

English

We will look at a range of stories, poems and non-fiction texts to support our writing and reading comprehension skills. These will include: The Lighthouse Keepers Lunch, The Very Hungry Caterpillar.

We will be finding out how to write a set of instructions and what time adverbs are.

Maths

We will be looking at multiplication and division at the beginning of the term. Where we will move into looking at fractions. We also be looking at place value to 20, 50 and 100. As well as consolidating our understanding of addition and subtraction.

Computing

We will starting with e-safety and how we can protect ourselves while using the internet at school and at home.

Design Technology

We will be learning about what a varied diet is and how we can prepare a balanced meal. We will then look at where food comes from.

We will be active outdoors learning strike, catch and field skills.

Religious Education

We will be looking at how faith is a part of our community and what it means to be part of a community. We will also look at how we should care for others

PSHE

We will learn how to keep ourselves healthy physically and mentally. We will then move on to looking at money and how you can earn money.
