Music - Ukulele


- The children will be learning to play the Ukulele this year.

Science - Electricity - How does electricity power the world?

Children will learn to:

- identify common appliances that run on electricity
- construct a simple series electrical circuit, identifying and naming its basic parts
- identify whether or not a lamp will light in a simple series circuit
- recognise that a switch opens and closes a circuit and associate this with whether or not a lamp lights in a simple series circuit
- recognise some common conductors and insulators, and associate metals with being good conductors

- Where Greece is on a map and know the capital city.
- How the world is divided.
- What the human and physical features are of Greece and London.
- The comparison between Ancient Greece and London.
